### Step-by-Step Guide:

## Creating Your Medicare.gov Account & Comparing Part D Drug Plans

### Step 1: Create Your Account

1. Go to [www.Medicare.gov](https://www.Medicare.gov)
2. Click **Login** in the top right corner.
3. On the next page, click **Create Account** in green.
4. Enter:
  - Your Medicare Number
  - Part A start date (and Part B if requested)
  - Follow the prompts to create a username, password, and security questions.
  - Once complete, log in to your new account.

### Step 2: Run a Part D Drug Plan Comparison



#### Find Plans

1. From your account dashboard, click **Health & Drug Plans** (upper right).
2. Select **Find Health & Drug Plans**.
3. Enter your ZIP code and click **Continue**.
4. Choose **Medicare Drug Plan (Part D)** and click **Find Plans**.



#### Add Your Medications

1. Select **Yes** to "Do you want to see your drug costs when you compare plans?"
2. Search for your first prescription, select it, then click **Add Drug**.
3. Enter dosage, quantity, and frequency, then click **Add to My Drug List**.
4. Repeat for all prescriptions, then click **Done Adding Drugs**.



#### Choose Your Pharmacies

1. Enter ZIP code, search for a pharmacy, and click **Add Pharmacy**.
2. Select up to five pharmacies, then click **Continue to View Plans**.


### Step 3: Review Plans & Enroll

On the results page you'll see:

- Plan name
- Monthly premium
- Yearly deductible
- Estimated annual drug costs



Click **Enroll** under your preferred plan to start the application.

 **Tip:** Have your Medicare card handy — you'll need your Medicare number to enroll.

### Alternative Option: Call Medicare

Prefer to have someone walk you through it?

Call **1-800-MEDICARE (800-633-4227)** and say **"Representative"** when prompted.



When asked why you're calling, say **"Part D Enrollment."**

#### Have ready:

- Date of birth
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security number
- Medicare Number from your red, white, and blue card
- List of your prescriptions and preferred pharmacies
